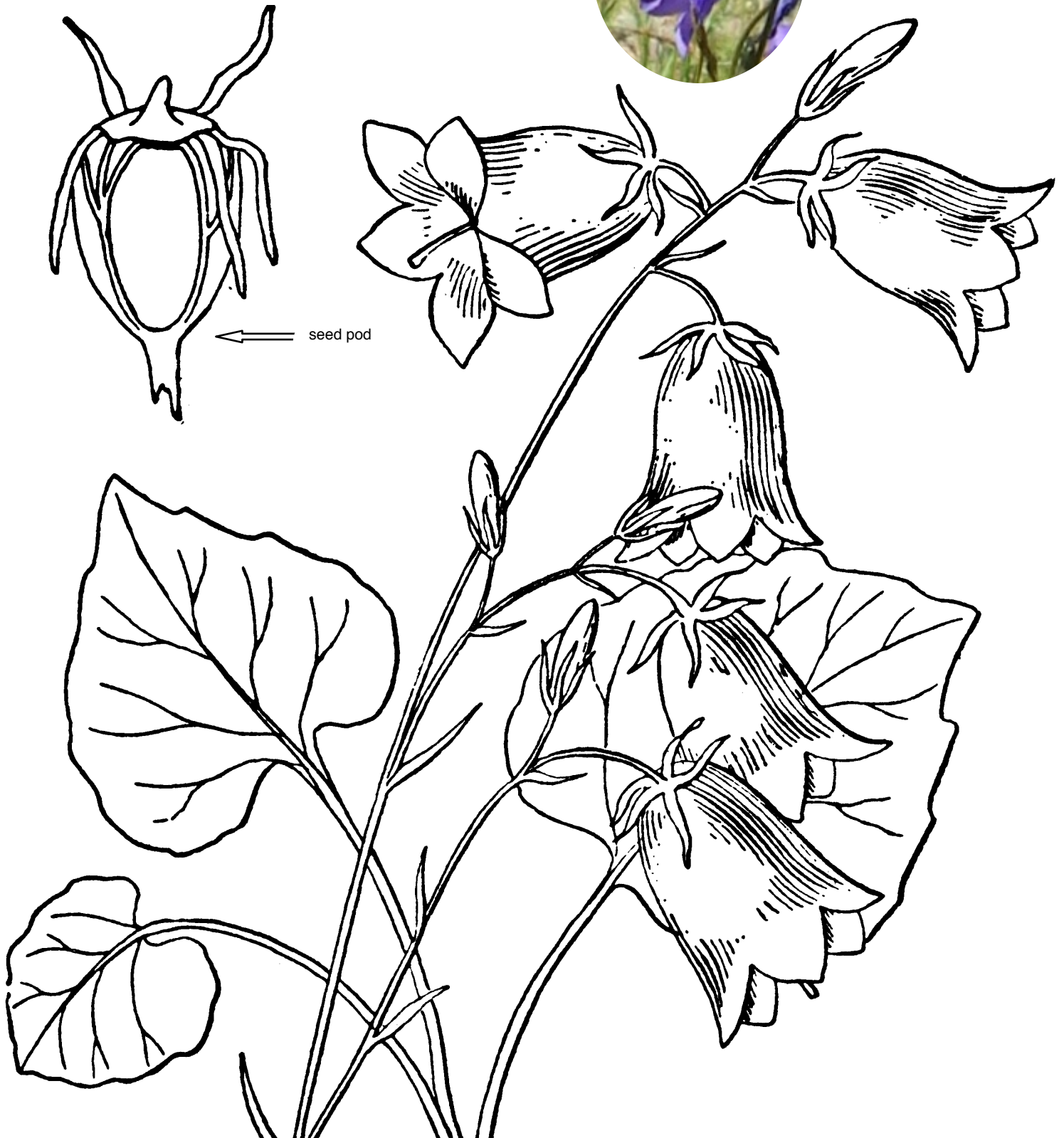
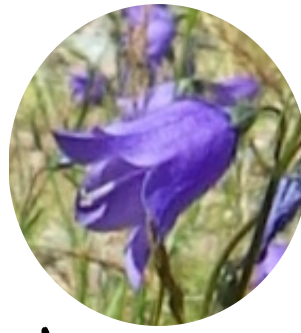


Harebell

Harebell is found commonly on the gravelly shores of our waterways. It is native to North America although this same plant grows in Scotland where it is popularly known as the bluebells of Scotland or Scotch bluebell. Harebell blooms continuously during the summer months. It is a source of nectar for hummingbirds and butterflies.
