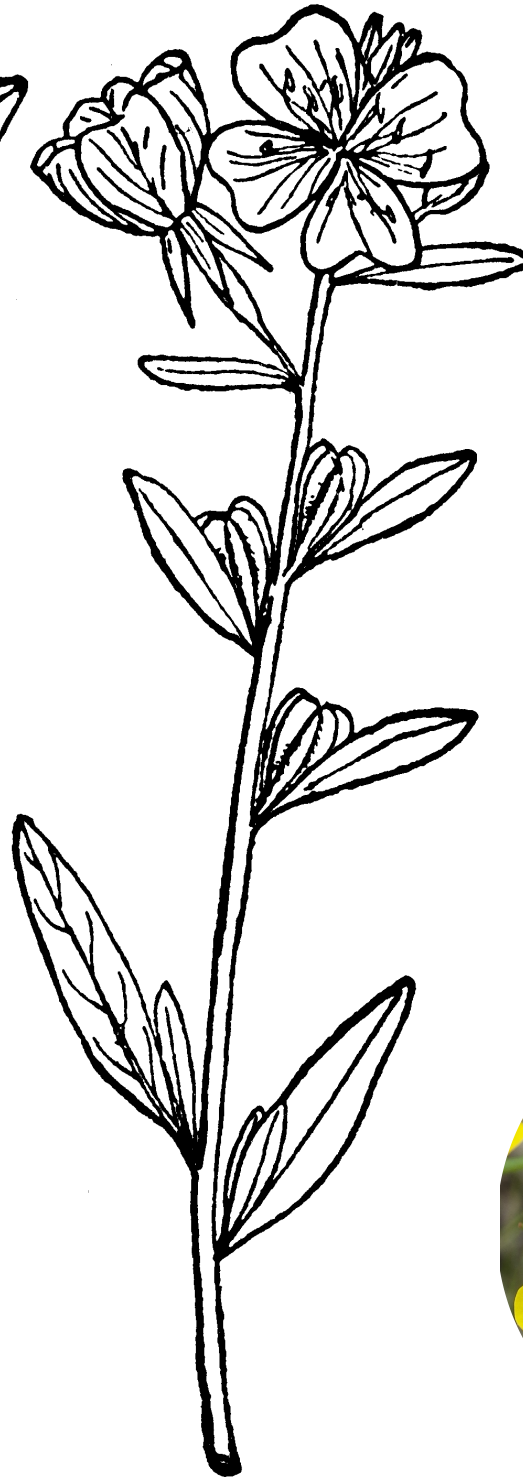
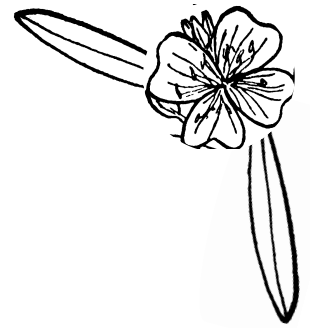


Sundrops

Sundrops are native to New Brunswick. The plants prefer moist soil and full sun. Their flowers begin in June and continue thru until August. Young roots can be eaten like a vegetable (with a peppery flavour), or the shoots can be eaten as a salad.
