Twin flower, native to North America, can be found as a creeping plant in mixed or coniferous forests and clearings. The plant is categorized as a dwarf shrub because of its many woody stems. The twin flowers appear in July and August producing a night fragrance that has been compared to lilacs. The plant is used by Native North Americans to brew medicinal tea.
